\$1.75 MILLION TO GO TO VICTIM'S ESTATE

Detroit City Council approved a \$1.75-million settlement to representatives of the estate of a man killed by a city bus on I-94 in 2005.

Vincent Dillard, 34, and two other victims, **Asukile Bennett**, 36, and Demetris Murry, 33, died after the bus crashed into their disabled sport-utility vehicle June 4, 2005. All were from Detroit.

Tuesday's settlement approval centers on representatives of Dillard's estate. Council unanimously approved the settlement.

State Police said the GMC Yukon became disabled on westbound I-94 near Trumbull when one of its wheels came off. The driver got the vehicle partially onto the shoulder, but part of it remained in the right lane.

Four men, including the three victims, got out of the vehicle, and the bus struck it, police said.
