## YPSILANTI: POLICE SEARCH FOR MAN SUSPECTED OF FATALLY STABBING HIS YOUNGER BROTHER

Ypsilanti **police** were searching **for** a 23-year-old **man** Saturday evening after he allegedly killed **his** younger **brother for** intervening in a fight with **his** girlfriend.

According to **police**, around 2:45 a.m., Mario Dennis Williams stabbed Bobby Mims, 19, **of** Detroit in the chest with a kitchen knife in the 600 block **of** Timberlane in Ypsilanti.

Williams, who stays in Ypsilanti Township and Detroit, had been arguing with **his** girlfriend when Mims tried serving as peacekeeper, **police** said.

"He was trying to keep a situation from escalating to a worse situation," Ypsilanti **Police** Sgt. Eddie Davis said.

Mims was taken to St. Joseph Hospital, where he was pronounced dead shortly after.

Williams fled the scene on foot, **police** said. It is believed that he doesn't have any means **of** transportation.

**Police** say they suspect he is still in the city or immediately outside it. They consider Williams to be armed and dangerous.

He is described by authorities as African American, 5 feet, 10 inches tall and 200 pounds. An outdated photo released after the crime shows him with braids. He now has short hair.
