

DETROIT: CRASH KILLS PEDESTRIAN AND MOTORCYCLE DRIVER

A **pedestrian** and the **driver** of a stolen **motorcycle** are dead after an accident Tuesday afternoon on Detroit's east side.

Michigan State Police said a trooper noticed the **motorcycle** traveling at a high rate of speed heading east on East Davison shortly before 3:30 p.m. and tried to get the **motorcycle driver** to pull over.

A short time later, the **motorcycle** struck the **pedestrian** at East Davison and Justine, killing the **driver** and the **pedestrian** . Police did not release their identities.

Remnants of the **motorcycle** were strewn across East Davison blocks away at Hasse.

Witnesses said they could hear the loud roaring of the **motorcycle** as it traveled down the street.

"You could hear it coming and then a loud **crash** ," said Toyia Walker, who was in the area at the time of the **crash** . "It was really loud."

Michigan State Police said the 2006 Honda **motorcycle** involved was reported stolen in an armed robbery on Oct. 24.

Troopers blocked both directions of East Davison between Conant and Hasse for several hours.
