David Ruffin's granddaughter shot dead

DETROIT - Mone Little, a 19-year-old **shot dead** Sunday night in a drive-by shooting on the city's west side, was identified by a family friend as the **granddaughter** of the late Motown singing great, **David** Ruffin.

Police responded to a call at 6612 Boxwood where a shooting was reported at 11:15 p.m. Witnesses told police that four persons, including Little, were leaving the house when a black Ford Crown Victoria pulled up and someone fired a volley of **shots** at the foursome, striking Little.

No one else was injured in the shooting.

Little's mother, Kimberly, is the youngest of **Ruffin's** three daughters. Family members could not be reached for comment.

Ruffin, a member of the Temptations, sang such Motown standards as "My Girl," "I Wish It Would Rain," and "Ain't Too Proud to Beg." Ruffin died of an accidental drug overdose in Philadelphia in 1991.
