Teens charged in 2 carjackings Two Detroit **teens** face a combined 25 felony charges after Warren police said they confessed to two **carjackings in** Warren on Wednesday morning that led to simultaneous police chases.

Devin J. Hudson, 17, faces 14 charges, including two counts of assault with intent to murder and two counts of **carjacking**. Eighteen-year-old Richard S. Harrell-Strong faces charges, including two counts of **carjacking**, two counts of armed robbery and two counts of conspiracy to commit **carjacking**.

Both entered not-guilty pleas at their arraignments Thursday before 37th District Court Judge John Chmura. Hudson's bond was set at \$3 million and Harrell-Strong's at \$2 million. The two are being held at the Macomb County Jail.

Warren police said the **teens** were involved **in** two **carjackings** from parking lots about 6 a.m. Wednesday. Police eventually arrested the **teens** after they were chased by vehicle into Hamtramck. Police are investigating the possible involvement of Hudson and Harrell-Strong **in carjackings in** Harper Woods, Madison Heights and Detroit.

Both are due back **in** court May 1 for a preliminary exam.
