

Ex-Detroit man pleads guilty

DETROIT -- A former Detroit **man** faces 30 years in prison after pleading **guilty** to money laundering and running the Black Mafia Family drug ring. Demetrius Flenory entered the plea Monday in U.S. District Court in Detroit. A sentencing date has not been scheduled. Flenory also must forfeit \$270 million in drug proceeds to the government. Federal prosecutors say the 39-year-old admitted to leading the drug organization for 15 years beginning in 1990. The Black Mafia Family is accused of dealing in large quantities of cocaine in the Detroit area, Kentucky, Georgia, Missouri, California and Texas. Flenory's brother and five others are scheduled to go on trial Nov. 26.
