Four life terms in slayings

DETROIT -- Charles (Little Charlie) Wilson was given four life sentences Wednesday for his part in the "Hart Street Massacre," in which four people were machine-gunned to death during a **drug** robbery.

Recorder's Court Judge Craig Strong also gave Wilson sentences of 10 to 20 years for assault with intent to murder, five to 15 years for armed robbery, and two years for using a firearm in the commission of a felony.

Wilson was convicted May 26 of being one of the gunmen in the Aug. 10 robbery of a marijuana **dealer** on **Detroit's** east side that left four people dead and one wounded.
