Reward offered for information in Warren shooting death

WARREN — The city's police department and CrimeStoppers are offering a \$2,000 **reward for information** leading to the arrest and conviction of suspects responsible **for the shooting death** of a Detroit man **in** March, Commissioner William Dwyer said.

Linzer Jennings, 25, was shot **in** the face **in** the parking lot of Royal Lanes on Dequindre at about 1:50 a.m. March 1, he said. He just walked out of Jumping Jacks Bar – located inside the bowling alley – with several friends when he was approached by two suspects.

Jennings died Tuesday at Henry Ford Health Care Nursing Home **in** Roseville after undergoing numerous surgeries at Royal Oak Beaumont Hospital. He never regained consciousness, Dwyer said.

"Due to the total disregard **for** human life that these suspects showed, our department will continue to aggressively investigate this homicide," Dwyer said **in** a statement.

The suspects, who fled the scene on foot, are described as: black males between 20 to 30 years old. One man is about 5 foot 6 inches to 5 foot 8 inches tall, with a thin build and wore a brown hooded sweatshirt.

The other man is about 5 foot 10 inches to 5 foot 11 inches tall, with a stocky build, light facial mustache that extends to a beard, braided shoulder-length hair, and wore a purple pull-over hooded jacket with white stripes along the shoulders and dark pants.
