Robbery suspects held after chase Two Detroit teens were arrested Wednesday in Warren **after** they allegedly robbed a Detroiter, then fled in a stolen car.

Martez Lajuan Norwood, 18, faces five felonies, including fleeing and eluding and carrying a concealed weapon. His 16-year-old passenger's name was not released because he is a minor.

Norwood and his passenger are accused of robbing a Detroit resident near Remington and Mitchell in Detroit about 2:30 a.m.

About 25 minutes later, Warren police noticed a red Ford Taurus traveling south on Groesbeck that stopped at a green light. Officers checked the license plate and found the vehicle had been reported stolen.

The officers ordered the Taurus to pull over, but the driver sped away, stopping only **after** hitting a curb in Weigand Park on Toepfer, police said.

The **suspects** ran, but the officers caught up to them.

Police said they found a bolt-action rifle across the front seat of the Taurus.

A preliminary exam for Norwood is set for Oct. 2 at Warren's 37th District Court. Information about the minor was not released by police.

Any **robbery** charges would be handled by Detroit police. Information on those charges was not available Wednesday.
