

TWO HELD IN DEATH OF DAUGHTER, 3

An east side Detroit couple was being held for investigation of murder Saturday after their three-year-old daughter was found dead in their home, suffering injuries police said came from "obvious abuse."

Latasha Powell died from "multiple injuries all over her body," according to the Wayne County Medical Examiner's Office.

Detroit police said the parents, **James Powell**, 37, and his wife, Diana, 33, were arrested at St. John Hospital, where the dead child was taken by an EMS crew called to the Lakeview Avenue home by the parents.

No warrants had been issued against them Saturday, but both will be held until sometime today, when warrants may be sought, police said.
